ELIGIBILITY

Open to all members of the NHCA plus 243 Racing All riders and passengers must have a current ACU Hillclimb or road race licence.

One event ACU licences will be available **(to UK residents up to 69 years of age only)** on the day, please indicate on the entry form if required.

There will be an entry fee of £80.00 for one machine, plus an extra £10.00 for sidecars. These fees include premiums for personal accident and third party insurance. The club (NHCA) undertakes to insure each driver and passenger, indemnifying him against any third party claims made arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other drivers or passengers, entrant, sponsor or mechanic. Only one machine per rider please.

Entry fees will only be returned if the entry is declined or the meeting is cancelled. The Association reserves the right to refuse entry, to abandon, cancel or postpone the meeting and alter the programme of events and awards.

No entry will be accepted after the closing date

CHANGE OF MACHINE/DRIVER AND/OR PASSENGER

The secretary of the meeting must be informed of any changes of motorcycle/driver and or passenger at the latest before the start of Technical Control on the morning of the meeting.

AWARDS

The meeting is a round of the National Hillclimb and Road Legal Championship. Points will be awarded for the NHCA Championship from the 2 competition runs as follows:-

- 1st place 6 points
- 2nd place 5 points
- 3rd place 4 points
- 4th place 3 points
- 5th place 2 points
- 6th place 1 points

There will be an extra 2 points awarded for breaking a class record in the competition runs.

PROGRAMME OF EVENTS

Solo's 100cc up to 250cc; 251-350cc; 351-500cc; 501-750cc; 751-1300cc

Sidecars 2 Track up to 1300cc with one driving wheel.

All other Sidecars Trikes and three-wheelers up to 1300cc.

Two competition runs will be made.

Where Championship runoff is not possible then outright Championship positions

taken from best of the competition runs.

REF Three track machines . Only single wheel drive and single wheel steering are eligible for Championship points

No Riders/Passengers under 16 years of age are eligible to compete at this event

COURSE

The course is 1448.25 metres long, gradually ascending in a series of left and right hand bends between farm buildings to the finish.

TECHNICAL CONTROL (starts at 8.00am)

Competitors **MUST** present their machines and clothing to Technical Control before practice.

Membership cards and ACU licences will be inspected.

DISPUTES

Protests and appeals must be made in accordance with the National sporting code.

PRACTICE

Competitors must start a minimum of two practice runs per machine, starting 9.00am . Competitors must walk the course prior to practice. **PLEASE NOTE** It is compulsory to attend the riders meeting.

START

Competitors commence runs from a standing clutch start. All runs are electronically timed.

FINISH

The finish line will be clearly marked. A braking area will be provided.

TYRES

Any type of tyre is permissible. No tyre warmers will be allowed.

Tyre warming is not permitted at this event

SAFETY

Crash helmets must be worn at all times when riding any machine particularly when returning from finish to paddock. All competitors must return to paddocks in-groups via Hill Climb Course only. No overtaking allowed. Return by other routes is strictly forbidden.

IDENTITY TAGS with name and date of birth must be worn

CAMPING

Overnight camping is available in the paddock.

DIRECTIONS

Harewood is situated North of Leeds on the A596 approximately 5 miles west of Collingham heading towards Otley

The consumption of alcohol is strictly forbidden on the day of the meeting, both before and during the event. Competitors failing to comply with this ruling will be disqualified from the competition.

Dogs must be controlled at all times during the meeting.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to animals.

Ensure the attached entry form is filled in and emailed to the secretary of the meeting

Entry fees must be brought to the event, attached to the original entry form and placed in the box Provided

Cheques and postal orders should be made out to the NATIONAL HILL CLIMB ASSOCIATION LTD.

For each rider and passenger who is under 18 years of age a fully completed parental Agreement form (single event) is required. Parent / legal guardian must be present at signing on and available for the duration of the event.
