## General Data Protection Regulation

In order for you to be a part of the NHCA, we are required to hold your personal details so we can provide a service. This can include your name, full address and contact details. This information is stored on a database held by our membership secretary which is made available to other club officials when needed. These details are kept within the National Hill Climb Association and are never shared to those outside the club.

The new law states that we must make the above information clear to you and be sure to let you know if we ever change these procedures. We are also required to set out your legal rights, which are as follows:

1. Ability to check what information we hold about you
2. Ability to request removal from our database
3. Ability to have history with us deleted
4. Ability to correct/change your details at any time
